IV. MAXIMIZE OPPORTUNITIES TO SERVE

- **A.** One of the benefits of being single is the freedom to serve without the responsibility of a spouse.
 - "32 But I want you to be without care. He who is unmarried cares for the things of the Lord—how he may please the Lord.
 - 33 But he who is married cares about the things of the world—how he may please his wife.
 - 34 There is a difference between a wife and a virgin. The unmarried woman cares about the things of the Lord, that she may be holy both in body and in spirit. But she who is married cares about the things of the world—how she may please her husband.
 - 35 And this I say for your own profit, not that I may put a leash on you, but for what is proper, and that you may serve the Lord without distraction." I Corinthians 7:32-35

MODERN FAMILY SINGLENESS

I. TRUST GOD WITH YOUR SITUATION

- **A.** Three kinds of single adults:
 - Single by creation God made them to live single "For I wish that all men were even as I myself. But each one has his own gift from God, one in this manner and another in that." I Corinthians 7:7
 - Single by <u>choice</u> Could pursue marriage, but choose to remain single for some reason.
 - Single by <u>circumstance</u> Would like to be married, but haven't found the right person.
- **B.** God has a wonderful and individual marital plan for you.

"So then he who gives her in marriage does well, but he who does not give her in marriage does better."

I Corinthians 7:38

II. DEVELOP GODLY RELATIONSHIPS

A. Develop a relationship with God.

"9 For in Him dwells all the fullness of the Godhead bodily;

10 and you are complete in Him, " Colossians 2:9-10a

- **B.** Develop a relationship with God's people.
 - "I Do not rebuke an older man, but exhort him as a father, younger men as brothers,
 - 2 older women as mothers, younger women as sisters, with all purity." I Timothy 5:1-2

III. ADOPT GOD'S STANDARD FOR SEX

A. God's standard for sex is between a man and a woman who are a husband and a wife.

"Marriage is honorable among all, and the bed undefiled; but fornicators and adulterers God will judge."

Hebrews 13:4

"3 For this is the will of God, your sanctification: that you should abstain from sexual immorality;

4 that each of you should know how to possess his own vessel in sanctification and honor," I Thessalonians 4:3-4

B. Sexual sin is not worse than other sin, but it is very different and more complex.

15 Do you not know that your bodies are members of Christ? Shall I then take the members of Christ and make them members of a harlot? Certainly not!

16 Or do you not know that he who is joined to a harlot is one body with her? For "the two," He says, "shall become one flesh."

17 But he who is joined to the Lord is one spirit with Him.

18 Flee sexual immorality. Every sin that a man does is outside the body, but he who commits sexual immorality sins against his own body.

19 Or do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and you are not your own?

20 For you were bought at a price; therefore glorify God in your body and in your spirit, which are God's."
