FOUR SPECIFIC MIRACLES

“For with God nothing will be impossible.” Luke 1:37

I. MIRACLE #1: GOD CAME TO EARTH

“15 He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation.

16 For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him.

17 And He is before all things, and in Him all things consist.”
Colossians 1:15-17

“I and My Father are one.” John 10:30

II. MIRACLE #2: GOD BECAME A MAN

“6 who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God,

7 but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men.

8 And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross.”
Philippians 2:6-8

“And she brought forth her firstborn Son, and wrapped Him in swaddling cloths, and laid Him in a manger, because there was no room for them in the inn.” Luke 2:7

III. MIRACLE #3: JESUS CAME FOR ALL OF US

“And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.” John 1:14

IV. MIRACLE #4: JESUS CAME FOR OUR BENEFIT
