

III. DECISION #3: CAREER

A. Look **up** and ask: God, what do you want me to do?

YOUR THREE MOST IMPORTANT DECISIONS

I. DECISION #1: CHRIST

“Jesus said to him, “I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.”

John 14:6

31 So they said, “Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and you will be saved, you and your household.” Acts 16:30-31

A. Establish a relationship with Christ.

- **Admit** that you are a sinner in need of a Savior.
“for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,” Romans 3:23

“For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.”
Romans 6:23
- **Believe** that Jesus Christ died on the cross for your sins and rose from the grave so that you could go to heaven.
“But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.”
Romans 5:8
“that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.” Romans 10:9
- **Call** upon the Lord through prayer for salvation.
“For “whoever calls on the name of the LORD shall be saved.” Romans 10:13

B. Grow in your relationship with Christ.

“but grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.... II Peter 3:18a

II. DECISION #2: COMPANION

A. Trust the Lord to meet this need in His way and time.
