A. Tell people by using the Romans Road.

The Road To Salvation - Five Guideposts

- Guidepost One – Romans 3:23

“for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,”

- Guidepost Two – Romans 6:23

“For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.”

- Guidepost Three – Romans 5:8

“But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.”

- Guidepost Four – Romans 10:9-10

“9 that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. 10 For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.”

- Guidepost Five – Romans 10:13

“For “whoever calls on the name of the LORD shall be saved.”

INTRODUCTION

HOW TO PRAY “LORD, SAVE THEM!”

I. UNITE WITH OUR CHURCH FAMILY

“Brethren, ...” Romans 10:1a

- A. The local church is to be a multigenerational family.
“Now, therefore, you are no longer strangers and foreigners, but fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God,” Ephesians 2:19
- B. Every Christian should belong to a local church.
“Then those who gladly received his word were baptized; and that day about three thousand souls were added to them.” Acts 2:41
- Accept Christ (2:41a).
 - Be baptized (2:41b).
 - Commit to a church family (2:41c).
- C. God wants us to make a difference by helping people to be saved.
*“22 And of some have compassion, making a difference:
23 And others save with fear, pulling them out of the fire; hating even the garment spotted by the flesh.”* Jude 22-23

II. DESIRE TO SEE PEOPLE SAVED

“...my heart’s desire...” Romans 10:1b

- A. God desires everyone to be saved.
*“3 For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior,
4 who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.”* I Timothy 2:3-4

- B. Paul desired Israel to be saved.

*“1 I tell the truth in Christ, I am not lying, my conscience also bearing me witness in the Holy Spirit,
2 that I have great sorrow and continual grief in my heart.
3 For I could wish that I myself were accursed from Christ for my brethren, my countrymen according to the flesh,”* Romans 9:1-3

- C. The people in hell desired family members to be saved.

*“27 “Then he said, ‘I beg you therefore, father, that you would send him to my father’s house,
28 for I have five brothers, that he may testify to them, lest they also come to this place of torment.’”* Luke 16:27-28

III. PRAY FOR THE UNSAVED

- A. Pray for the lost.
