WEEKLY READINGS

6. According to Hebrews 13:6 and Jeremiah 1:9, what two things specifically does God promise to “provide” when we go out to spread the gospel?

Thursday: Mat.28:19b-20a; Heb.9:27;Mat.25:41,46;Rom.10:13-14

7. From your observation, what lies at the “heart” of Jesus’s command to go *“and make disciples of all nations”*? What should be our motive to do this?
8. Matthew 25: 41, 46 defines Hell as a place of *“everlasting fire”* and *“everlasting punishment.”* How many have YOU shared this truth with?
9. What action is Romans 10:14 “clearly calling” us all to as believers?

Friday: Mat. 28:19a; Mark 16:15; II Cor. 9:6; II Cor. 10:15b-16a
