HOW TO FIGHT FOR YOUR FAITHFULNESS

I. RELY ON GOD'S STRENGTH, NOT YOUR OWN

"Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might." Ephesians 6:10

"So he answered and said to me: "This is the word of the LORD to Zerubbabel: 'Not by might nor by power, but by My Spirit,' Says the LORD of hosts.:" Zechaariah 4:6

"I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me." Philippians 4:13

II. KNOW YOUR ENEMY IS THE DEVIL

"11 Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. 12 For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places." Ephesians 6:11-12

"8 Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour.

9 Resist him, steadfast in the faith..." I Peter 5:8-9a

III. PUT ON THE ARMOR OF GOD

"Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand." Ephesians 6:13

Paul was in a Roman prison cell when he wrote Ephesians and was surrounded by Roman soldiers.

"Now when we came to Rome, the centurion delivered the prisoners to the captain of the guard; but Paul was permitted to dwell by himself with the soldier who guarded him." Acts 28:16

THE WHOLE ARMOR OF GOD

A. Put on the belt of truth.

"Stand therefore, having girded your waist with truth,..." Ephesians 6:14a

The truth is Jesus.

 B. Put on the breastplate of righteousness.
"… having put on the breastplate of righteousness," Ephesians 6:14b

Righteousness is obedience to God.

C. Put on the gospel of peace. *"and having shod your feet with the preparation of the gospel of peace;"* Ephesians 6:15

Peace is peace with God which comes through salvation.

D. Put on the shield of faith.

"above all, taking the shield of faith with which you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one." Ephesians 6:16

Faith is confident obedience to the Word of God regardless of circumstances or consequences.

E. Put on the helmet of salvation.

"And take the helmet of salvation, ... "

Ephesians 6:17a

Salvation is total deliverance.
