I. ACCEPT GOD'S POWER TO GO

¹⁸ *And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth."*

Matthew 28:18

A. The word "authority" means power. Have you ever thought about how powerful God is?

⁸ *Let all the earth fear the LORD; Let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of Him.*

⁹ *For He spoke, and it was done; He commanded, and it stood fast."* Psalm 33:8-9

¹¹ *But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you."* Romans 8:11

B. God will give you power to go. The gospel of Christ is the power of God.

II. BELIEVE GOD IS WITH YOU WHEN YOU GO

".....and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Amen." Matthew 28:20b

A. God will be with you to provide courage.

⁶ *So we may boldly say: "The LORD is my helper; I will not fear. What can man do to me?"*

B. God will be with you to provide words.

⁹ *Then the LORD put forth His hand and touched my mouth, and the LORD said to me:*

"Behold, I have put My words in your mouth."

III. CARE ENOUGH FOR PEOPLE TO GO

¹⁹ *.....and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,*

A. Everyone is going to die and face the judgement of God.

²⁷ *And as it is appointed for men to die once, but after this the judgment,"* Hebrews 9:27

B. Hell is a real eternal destination and a place of suffering.

⁴¹ *"Then He will also say to those on the left hand, 'Depart from Me, you cursed, into the everlasting fire prepared for the devil and his angels:*

⁴⁶ *And these will go away into everlasting punishment, but the righteous into eternal life."* Matthew 25: 41, 46
