#### HOW TO GO WITH COMMITMENT

#### I. OUR LORD'S COMMITMENT TO HIS FOLLOWERS

A. All Power: Christ's own authority in Heaven and on Earth endowed to us.

"18 And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth."

Matthew 28:18a

B. Always Presence: Immanuel's empowering Spirit within "going" believers.

"20 ...and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Amen." Matthew 28:20b

As God sent His Son, our Lord commands us to... GO, with Commitment!

## II. THE CHRISTIAN'S COMMITMENT TO OBEY OUR LORD JESUS

A. All Places: go, targeting every Unreached People Groups where the Gospel has NOT gone!

"19 Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit," Matthew 28:19a B. All Precepts: teach, train "to do", obey all commands; start with this!

"20 teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you..." Matthew 28:20a

### Why we lack commitment:

- Convenient time.
- Comfortable place.
- Callous hearts.

## III. PAUL'S TWO-FOLD RESOLUTION AS THE STRATEGIC SOLUTION

"19 in mighty signs and wonders, by the power of the Spirit of God, so that from Jerusalem and round about to Illyricum I have fully preached the gospel of Christ.

<sup>20</sup> And so I have made it my aim to preach the gospel, not where Christ was named, lest I should build on another man's foundation," Romans 15:19-20

- A. Foundations: build, not on another's, but where there is none.
- B. Focus: targeting the Gospel to those who have never heard.

Failure is when we don't outreach to the unreached. We are to reach those who are not like you and not near you.
