

III. HAVE A SUPER VISION OF GOING

Who is God calling you to invest and invite?

A. Be available to go.

“⁸ Also I heard the voice of the Lord, saying: “Whom shall I send, and who will go for us?” Then I said, ‘Here am I! Send me.’” Isaiah 6:8

Growing requires the greatest ability which is availability.

“³⁶ But when He saw the multitudes, He was moved with compassion for them, because they were weary and scattered, like sheep having no shepherd.

³⁷ Then He said to His disciples, “The harvest truly is plentiful, but the laborers are few.

³⁸ Therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest.” Matthew 9:36-38

B. Be obedient to go.

“⁹ And He said, ‘Go, and tell this people...’” Isaiah 6:9a

Growing results in the joy of being a laborer in God’s harvest.

“³⁵ Do you not say, ‘There are still four months and then comes the harvest’? Behold, I say to you, lift up your eyes and look at the fields, for they are already white for harvest!” John 4:35

Make Heaven Crowded Principle:

Your vision can lead you to eternal impact.

“⁸ Also, I heard the voice of the Lord, saying: ‘Whom shall I send, And who will go for Us?’ Then I said, ‘Here am I! Send me.’”

I. HAVE A SUPER VISION OF GOD

What is God like?

A. God is in heaven.

“¹ In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord sitting on a throne, high and lifted up, and the train of His robe filled the temple.

² Above it stood seraphim; each one had six wings: with two he covered his face, with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew.”

Isaiah 6:1-2

God wants you in heaven with Him.

“¹⁸ For Christ also suffered once for sins, the just for the unjust, that He might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh but made alive by the Spirit,”

I Peter 3:18

B. God is holy.

“³ And one cried to another and said: ‘Holy, holy holy is the LORD of hosts; The whole earth is full of His glory!’”

⁴ And the posts of the door were shaken by the voice of him who cried out, and the house was filled with smoke.”

Isaiah 6:3-4

God wants you to be holy like Him.

“¹⁴ as obedient children, not conforming yourselves to the former lusts, as in your ignorance;

¹⁵ but as He who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct,

¹⁶ because it is written, ‘Be holy, for I am holy.’”

I Peter 1:14-16

II. HAVE A SUPER VISION OF GROWING

How do you need to grow?

A. Identify and confess your sin to God.

“⁵ So I said: ‘Woe is me, for I am undone! Because I am a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips; For my eyes have seen the King, The LORD of hosts.’”

Isaiah 6:5

Growing requires you to confess your specific sin (a sinful tongue).

“¹³ He who covers his sins will not prosper, But whoever confesses and forsakes them will have mercy.”

Proverbs 28:13

B. Know that you are forgiven and ready to be used by God.

“⁶ Then one of the seraphim flew to me, having in his hand a live coal which he had taken with the tongs from the altar.

⁷ And he touched my mouth with it, and said: “‘Behold, this has touched your lips; Your iniquity is taken away, and your sin purged.’”

Isaiah 6:6-7

Growing through confession results in cleansing and being used of God.

“⁹ If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.”

I John 1:9

“¹⁹ Nevertheless the solid foundation of God stands, having this seal: “The Lord knows those who are His,” and, “Let everyone who names the name of Christ depart from iniquity.”

²⁰ But in a great house there are not only vessels of gold and silver, but also of wood and clay, some for honor and some for dishonor.

²¹ Therefore if anyone cleanses himself from the latter, he will be a vessel for honor, sanctified and useful for the Master, prepared for every good work.”
