I. WE ARE TEMPTED BUT GOD OVERCOMES

- A. We all face temptation.
 - ¹² "Therefore, let him who thinks he stands take heed lest he fall.
 - ¹³ No temptation has overtaken you except such as is common to man..."

- B. Temptation is our oldest problem.
 - ¹ "Now the serpent was more cunning than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said to the woman, "Has God indeed said, 'You shall not eat of every tree of the garden'?" Genesis 3:1
- C. It is not a sin to be tempted, only if we yield to it.

II. BUT GOD IS FAITHFUL

- A. God is faithful to control temptation.

- B. God is faithful to conquer temptation.
 - 13 "...but with the temptation will also make the way of escape, that you may be able to bear it."

 I Corinthians 10:13c

III. OVERCOME TEMPTATION

A. Refuse to be intimidated.
