B. Mature believers are humble, loving and focused on God.

HOW TO GROW IN MATURITY

I Corinthians 3:9a says, "you are God's field." This means God will beautifully cultivate your life for growth and maturity.

"Blessed is the man who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor stands in the path of sinners, nor sits in the seat of the scornful;" Psalm 1:1

I. BE CONTROLLED BY THE HOLY SPIRIT

- A. The natural man is unsaved and does not have the Holy Spirit.
 - 14 "But the natural man does not receive the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him; nor can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned." I Corinthians 2:14
- B. The carnal man is saved, but immature because they are not controlled by the Holy Spirit.
 - ¹ "And I, brethren, could not speak to you as to spiritual people but as to carnal, as to babes in Christ." I Corinthians 3:1
- C. The spiritual man is saved and mature because they are controlled by the Holy Spirit.
 - ¹⁵ "But he who is spiritual judges all things, yet he himself is rightly judged by no one.
 - ¹⁶ For 'who has known the mind of the LORD that he may instruct Him?' But we have the mind of Christ." I Corinthians 2:15-16
 - ¹⁶ "I say then: Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh." Galatians 5:16
 - ⁵ "Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus," Philippians 2:5

II. BE NOURISHED WITH THE WORD OF GOD
