HOW GOD CARES FOR HUMANITY

I. GOD'S CREATION WAS GLORIOUS AND PERFECT

¹ "O LORD, our Lord, how excellent is Your name in all the earth, who have set Your glory above the heavens!

² Out of the mouth of babes and nursing infants You have ordained strength, because of Your enemies, that You may silence the enemy and the avenger." Psalm 8:1-2

- A. Humanity was created in the image of God.
 - ²⁷ "So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them."

 Genesis 1:27
- B. God called His creation after He made man; "very good"!
 - 31 "Then God saw everything that He had made, and indeed it was very good. So the evening and the morning were the sixth day." Genesis 1:31
- C. Humanity became a subject of God's delight.
 - 31 "Rejoicing in His inhabited world, and my delight was with the sons of men." Proverbs 8:31

II. HUMANITY'S ELEVATION OVER CREATION

- A. Man is relatively insignificant compared to God's immense power in creation.
 - ³ "When I consider Your heavens, the work of Your fingers, the moon and the stars, which You have ordained, ⁴ What is man that You are mindful of him, and the son of man that You visit him?" Psalm 8:3-4
- B. Despite this comparison man was given dominion over creation to manage the world God made.
 - ²⁶ "Then God said, 'Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth.'" Genesis 1:26

III. SIN STOLE THE GLORY

Devil's strategy:

A. Doubting God's commandments and accepting Satan's lies.

¹⁶ "And the LORD God commanded the man, saying, 'Of every tree of the garden you may freely eat;

how the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat of it you shall surely die.'"
