Jesus provided "a great number of fish" (5:6) after "they let down the net" (5:5).

### V. JESUS PROVIDES FOR YOUR NEEDS TO GROW YOUR MATURITY

Jesus initially ask Peter to "put out a little from the land" ((5:3).

But later he asked Peter to "launch out into the deep" (5:4).

Jesus took Peter out to the deep water to deepen his faith.

#### HOW JESUS PROVIDES FOR YOUR NEEDS

#### I. JESUS KNOWS YOUR NEEDS BEFORE YOU DO

<sup>1</sup> "So it was, as the multitude pressed about Him to hear the word of God, that He stood by the Lake of Gennesaret, <sup>2</sup> and saw two boats standing by the lake; but the fishermen had gone from them and were washing their nets."

Luke 5:1-2

Jesus knew Peter had a physical and spiritual need.

<sup>31</sup> "Therefore, do not worry, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?'

<sup>32</sup> For after all these things the Gentiles seek. For your heavenly Father knows that you need all these things."

Matthew 6:31-32

### II. JESUS PROVIDES FOR YOUR NEEDS WHEN YOU TURN TOWARD HIM

<sup>3</sup> "Then He got into one of the boats, which was Simon's, and asked him to put out a little from the land. And He sat down and taught the multitudes from the boat."

Luke 5:3

Jesus got into Peter's boat and asked him to steer the boat. Peter obeyed and naturally turned towards Jesus as He taught the multitudes.

### III. JESUS PROVIDES FOR YOUR NEEDS THROUGH OBEDIENCE

<sup>4</sup> "When He had stopped speaking, He said to Simon, 'Launch out into the deep and let down your nets for a catch.'

<sup>5</sup> But Simon answered and said to Him, 'Master, we have toiled all night and caught nothing; nevertheless, at Your word I will let down the net.'" Luke 5:4-5

Jesus' blessings followed Peter's obedience.

<sup>17</sup> "So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God." Romans 10:17

<sup>3</sup> "Is this not the carpenter, the Son of Mary, and brother of James, Joses, Judas, and Simon? And are not His sisters here with us?" So they were offended at Him." Mark 6:3

Peter calls Jesus, "Master" (5:5).

By using this word Peter is saying Jesus is his commander and he is willing to take orders from him.

## IV. JESUS PROVIDES FOR YOUR NEEDS BOTH NATURALLY AND SUPERNATURALLY

<sup>6</sup> "And when they had done this, they caught a great number of fish, and their net was breaking.

<sup>7</sup> So they signaled to their partners in the other boat to come and help them. And they came and filled both the boats, so that they began to sink.

<sup>8</sup> When Simon Peter saw it, he fell down at Jesus' knees, saying, "Depart from me, for I am a sinful man, O Lord!" <sup>9</sup> For he and all who were with him were astonished at the catch of fish which they had taken;" Luke 5:6-9
