# HOW TO TRUST JESUS IN YOUR STORMS

Faith is confident obedience to the Word of God regardless of circumstances or consequences.

# I. RECOGNIZE GOD'S STORMS

<sup>22</sup> "Immediately Jesus made His disciples get into the boat and go before Him to the other side, while He sent the multitudes away.

<sup>23</sup> And when He had sent the multitudes away, He went up on the mountain by Himself to pray. Now when evening came, He was alone there.

<sup>24</sup> But the boat was now in the middle of the sea, tossed by the waves, for the wind was contrary." Matthew 14:22-24

Storms always have a purpose.

There are two kinds of storms:

- Storms of correction for discipline.
  - <sup>1</sup>"Now the word of the LORD came to Jonah the son of Amittai, saying,
  - <sup>2</sup> 'Arise, go to Nineveh, that great city, and cry out against it; for their wickedness has come up before Me.'
  - <sup>3</sup> But Jonah arose to flee to Tarshish from the presence of the LORD. He went down to Joppa, and found a ship going to Tarshish; so he paid the fare, and went down into it, to go with them to Tarshish from the presence of the LORD.
  - <sup>4</sup> But the LORD sent out a great wind on the sea, and there was a mighty tempest on the sea, so that the ship was about to be broken up." Jonah 1:1-4
- Storms of perfection for growth.
  - <sup>6</sup> "In this you greatly rejoice, though now for a little while, if need be, you have been grieved by various trials,
  - <sup>7</sup> that the genuineness of your faith, being much more precious than gold that perishes, though it is tested by fire, may be found to praise, honor, and glory at the revelation of Jesus Christ," I Peter 1:6-7

# II. REALIZE GOD'S PRESENCE

- <sup>25</sup> "Now in the fourth watch of the night Jesus went to them, walking on the sea.
- <sup>26</sup> And when the disciples saw Him walking on the sea, they were troubled, saying, 'It is a ghost!' And they cried out for fear.
- <sup>27</sup> But immediately Jesus spoke to them, saying, 'Be of good cheer! It is I; do not be afraid.'"

God never promised to keep you from storms, but He did promise to be with you through storms.

# III. RECEIVE GOD'S WORD

- <sup>28</sup> "And Peter answered Him and said, 'Lord, if it is You, command me to come to You on the water.'

Faith is not taking a blind step into the darkness of this world, but a bold step into the light of His Word.
