HOW JESUS STRENGTHENS YOUR CONFIDENCE

- This passage reveals the miracle of the transfiguration of Jesus. Up to this point Jesus has physically hid His divinity within His humanity. Now He is transfigured for Peter, James and John to see His deity.
- The purpose of the transfiguration was to strengthen the confidence of Jesus' core disciples that He was God in human flesh and the Savior of the world.

I. SEE THE GLORY OF GOD

- A. The participants in the transfiguration were Peter, James and John.
 - ²⁸ "Now it came to pass, about eight days after these sayings that He took Peter, John, and James and went up on the mountain to pray." Luke 9:28
- B. The portrayal of the transfiguration was Jesus radiating the glory of His divine nature.
 - ²⁹ "As He prayed, the appearance of His face was altered, and His robe became white and glistening."

Luke 9:29

C. Strengthen your confidence by seeing the glory of God.

II. OBEY THE WILL OF GOD

- A. The characters were Moses, Elijah, and Jesus.
 - ³⁰ "And behold, two men talked with Him, who were Moses and Elijah," Luke 9:30
 - Moses represented the law.
 - ⁵ "So Moses the servant of the LORD died there in the land of Moab, according to the word of the LORD.

 ⁶ And He buried him in a valley in the land of Moab, opposite Beth Peor; but no one knows his grave to this day."

 Deuteronomy 34:5-6
 - Elijah represented the prophets.
 - ¹¹ "Then it happened, as they continued on and talked, that suddenly a chariot of fire appeared with horses of fire, and separated the two of them; and Elijah went up by a whirlwind into heaven."

II Kings 2:11

- Jesus came to fulfill the law and the prophets.
 - ¹⁷ "Do not think that I came to destroy the Law or the Prophets. I did not come to destroy but to fulfill.

 ¹⁸ For assuredly, I say to you, till heaven and earth pass away, one jot or one tittle will by no means pass from the law till all is fulfilled."

- B. The conversation was about Jesus' death.
 - 31 "who appeared in glory and spoke of His decease which He was about to accomplish at Jerusalem."

- C. Strengthen your confidence by obeying the will of God.
 - ² "And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God."
